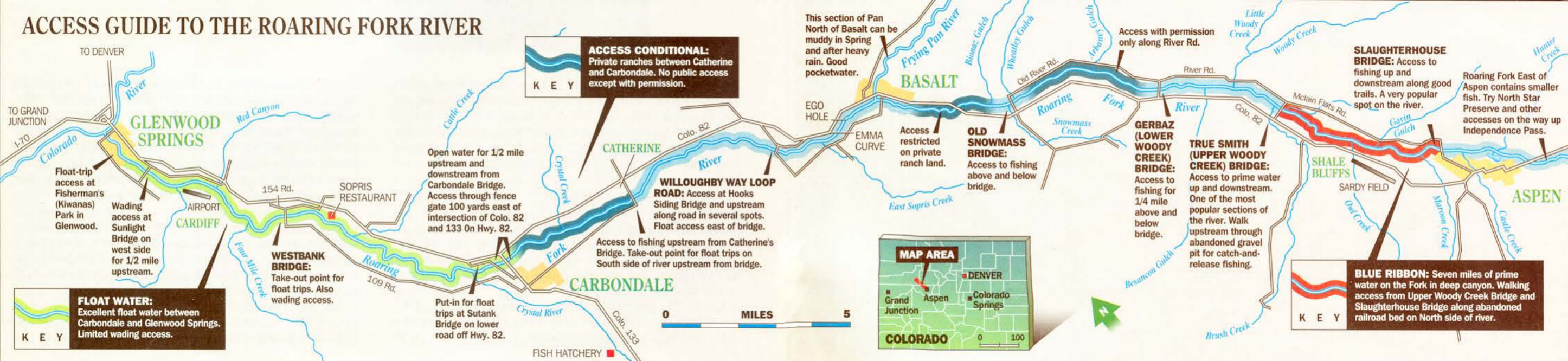


# ACCESS GUIDE TO THE ROARING FORK RIVER



TO DENVER  
TO GRAND JUNCTION  
I-70

**GLENWOOD SPRINGS**

Float-trip access at Fisherman's (Kiwanas) Park in Glenwood.

Wading access at Sunlight Bridge on west side for 1/2 mile upstream.

**WESTBANK BRIDGE:** Take-out point for float trips. Also wading access.

109 Rd.

**WILLOUGHBY WAY LOOP ROAD:** Access at Hooks Siding Bridge and upstream along road in several spots. Float access east of bridge.

133 On Hwy. 82

Open water for 1/2 mile upstream and downstream from Carbondale Bridge. Access through fence gate 100 yards east of intersection of Colo. 82 and 133 On Hwy. 82.

Put-in for float trips at Sutank Bridge on lower road off Hwy. 82.

FISH HATCHERY

**KEY**

**FLOAT WATER:** Excellent float water between Carbondale and Glenwood Springs. Limited wading access.

**KEY**

**ACCESS CONDITIONAL:** Private ranches between Catherine and Carbondale. No public access except with permission.

This section of Pan North of Basalt can be muddy in Spring and after heavy rain. Good pocketwater.

**BASALT**

EGO HOLE

EMMA CURVE

Access restricted on private ranch land.

**OLD SNOWMASS BRIDGE:** Access to fishing above and below bridge.

**GERBAZ (LOWER WOODY CREEK) BRIDGE:** Access to fishing for 1/4 mile above and below bridge.

**TRUE SMITH (UPPER WOODY CREEK) BRIDGE:** Access to prime water up and downstream. One of the most popular sections of the river. Walk upstream through abandoned gravel pit for catch-and-release fishing.

**SLAUGHTERHOUSE BRIDGE:** Access to fishing up and downstream along good trails. A very popular spot on the river.

Roaring Fork East of Aspen contains smaller fish. Try North Star Preserve and other accesses on the way up Independence Pass.

**KEY**

**BLUE RIBBON:** Seven miles of prime water on the Fork in deep canyon. Walking access from Upper Woody Creek Bridge and Slaughterhouse Bridge along abandoned railroad bed on North side of river.
